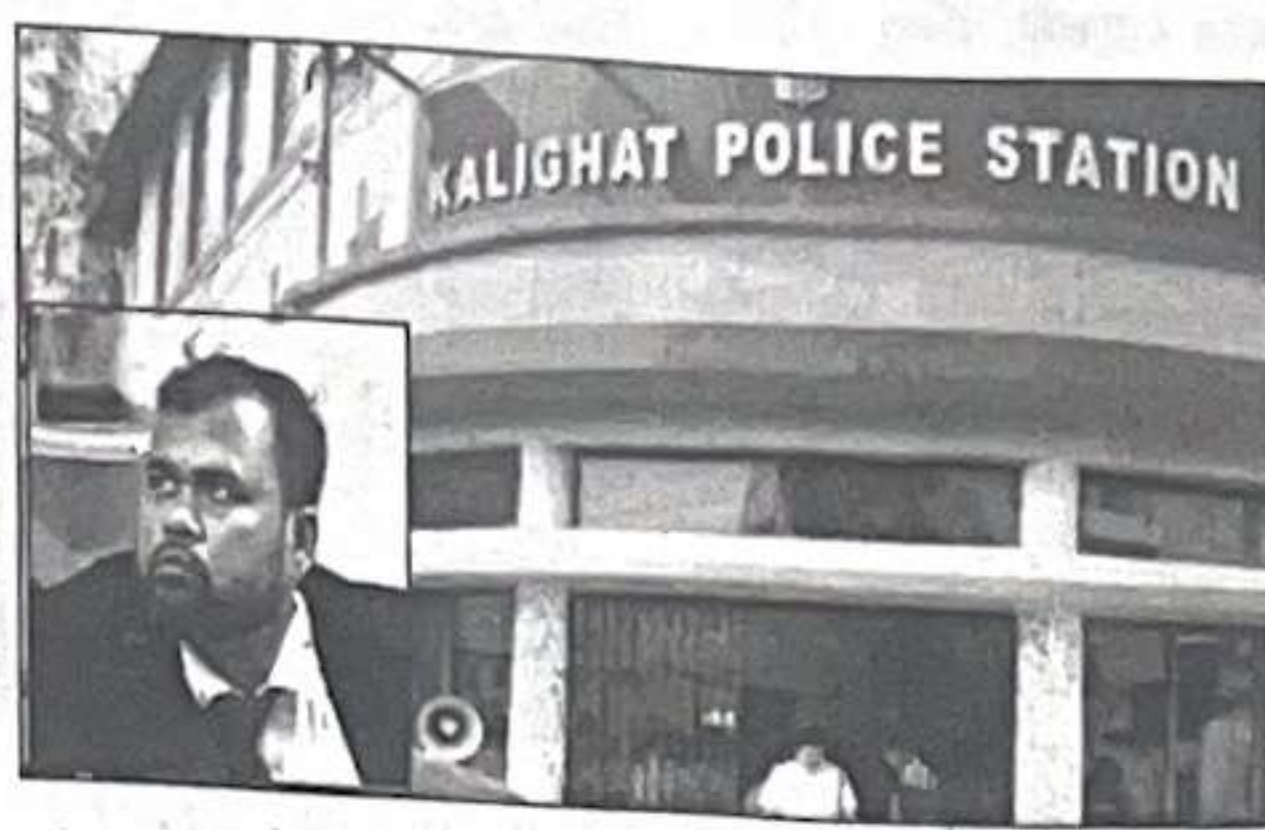


# মুখ্যমন্ত্রীর বাড়ির সামনে গ্রেফতারের ঘটনায় মণিপুরের জিএসটি অফিসারের বয়ান রেকর্ড

উজ্জ্বল দত্ত, কলকাতা : ২১ জুলাই তৃণমূল কংগ্রেসের শহিদ দিবস পালনের দিন সকালে জনসভার আগে কালাীঘাটে মুখ্যমন্ত্রী মমতা বন্দোপাধ্যায়ের বাড়ির কাছে যুবক নূর আমিন গাড়ি নিয়ে ঢেকার চেষ্টা করেন। এরপরই পুলিশ প্রথমে তাঁকে আটক করে। পরে গাড়িতে তল্লাশি চালানোর পর নূরকে গ্রেফতার করা হয়। এই ঘটনায় নূর আমিনের প্রকৃত পরিচয় জানতে সোমবার মণিপুরের এক জিএসটি অফিসারের বয়ান রেকর্ড করে কালাীঘাট থানা। জানা গেছে, নূর আমিন জিএসটি অফিসারদের এক অভিযানে তথ্য দেওয়ার কেন্দ্রীয় সরকারের কাছ থেকে ১৮ লাখ টাকা পান। জিএসটির পক্ষ থেকে নূরকে ১টি সার্টিফিকেটও দেওয়া হয়েছিল। নূরকে বাড়ি তল্লাশির সময় কালাীঘাট থানার পুলিশ ওই সার্টিফিকেট হস্তগত করে। সেই ঘটনায়

তদন্তে পুলিশ জানতে পারে এই বিখ্যাতই পুলিশের জাল আর্ট কার্ড, বিএসএফ কার্ড ও জাল নূরকে তৈরি করে দিয়েছিল। ২১ জুলাই থেকেই বিখ্যাত পুলিশ হেফাজতে রয়েছে। তার প্রিন্সিপাল বানমা রয়েছে। প্রসঙ্গত, ২১ জুলাই মমতা বন্দোপাধ্যায়ের বাড়ির পুলিশ থেকে অল্প-সহ নূর আমিনকে ধরা হয়। প্রথমে তাঁর পরিচয় নিয়ে গঠিত ছিল। তবে ধীরে ধীরে পুলিশ জিজ্ঞাসাবাদে উঠে এসেছে একেই বনমা এক চাকরবান্দর তথা। জানা গেছে, তিনি আনন্দপুরের বাসিন্দা। হিউমান রিসোর্স প্রফেশনাল অ্যাসোসিয়েশনের সঙ্গে জড়িত।

## ভটপাড়া হাসপাতালে পানীয় জলের সমস্যা

প্রতীতি ঘোষ, বারাকপুর : ভটপাড়া স্টেট জেনারেল হাসপাতালের রোগী ও তাদের পরিবার পানীয় জলের সমস্যা জেরবার। উত্তর ২৪ পরগণার এই শিল্পাঞ্চলে ভটপাড়া স্টেট জেনারেল হাসপাতালে রোগীর চাপ অত্যধিক। ভটপাড়া ও জগদল বিধানসভা কেন্দ্রের পাশাপাশি পানের নোয়াপাড়া বিধানসভা অঞ্চলের মানুষও এখানে চিকিৎসার জন্য আসে। অভিযোগ উঠেছে, গত ২-৩ মাস ধরে পানীয় জলের সমস্যা তৃষ্ণা এই হাসপাতাল। এছাড়া হাসপাতাল জুড়ে যেখানে-সেখানে কুকুর-বিড়াল ঘুরে বেড়াচ্ছে। এনিবে বারবার হাসপাতাল সুপারকে জানানো হয়েছে। তিনি যাবতীয় নেনে বলেও কাজ এগোয়নি বলে অভিযোগ। রোগীর পরিবারে লোকেরা জানান, এখানে টাকে যে জল থাকে তা অস্বাস্থ্যকর হওয়ায় বাওয়ার সঙ্কব নয়।

## সাংসদের গাড়ি দুর্ঘটনায় বর্ধমান থানায় অভিযোগ

বিপুল ভট্টাচার্য, বর্ধমান : রবিবার বর্ধমান স্টেশনের এক অনুষ্ঠানে সেরে কলকাতায় ফেরার মধ্যে বর্ধমান দুর্গাপুর লোকসভার বিজেপি সাংসদ সুরেন্দ্রজিৎ সিংহ অহলুভালিয়ার গাড়ির ধাক্কা এক মহিলা জখম হন। ওই ঘটনায় বর্ধমান থানায় লিখিত অভিযোগ দায়ের করেন জখম মহিলার মেয়ে। এদিকে, বিজেপির অভিযোগ, উদ্দেশ্যপ্রসন্নভাবেই সাংসদের বিরুদ্ধে তৃণমূল কংগ্রেস জখমের মেয়েকে দিয়ে থানায় অভিযোগ করতে বাধ্য করেছে। উল্লেখ্য, রবিবার বিজেপি সাংসদের গাড়ির ধাক্কা জখম হন বর্ধমানের ভাতছালার বাসিন্দা উষা হাটি। তাকে বর্ধমান হাসপাতালে ভর্তি করা হয়। এরপরই রবিবার রাতে বর্ধমান থানায় উষা হাটির মেয়ে সনিয়া হাটি লিখিত অভিযোগ দায়ের করেন। অভিযোগে সনিয়া হাটি জানান, রবিবার দুপুর প্রায় ১টা ২০মিনিট নাগাদ তাঁর মা সাইকেল নিয়ে যাচ্ছিলেন, ওইসময় সাংসদের গাড়ি তাঁকে ধাক্কা মারলে তিনি রাস্তায় পড়ে যান। এই অবস্থায় সাংসদের গাড়ি থেকে নামেননি। অন্য একজন গাড়ি থেকে নেমে তাঁর মাকে ওই অবস্থায় পড়ে থাকতে দেখেই ফের গাড়িতে চেপে চলে যান।

## বাগজোলা খালের ওপর সেতুর কাজ জোরকদমে

অজল আচার্য, দমদম : ২০২২ সালের আগস্ট মাসে দমদম রোডের বাগজোলা খালের ওপর যে সেতু রয়েছে তার একাংশ ধসে যায়। তড়িৎদ্বি গুরুত্বপূর্ণ এই রাস্তায় ধসে যাওয়া অংশকে পাল্টা দিয়ে থিরে ছোঁটো খান চলাচলের ব্যবস্থা করে দক্ষিণ দমদম পুরসভা ও পূর্ব দক্ষিণের ওই রাস্তা ও সেতু দিয়ে ভারী যানবাহন চলাচল নিষেধাজ্ঞা চাপানো হয়। এভাবেই চলছিল প্রায় দেড় বছর। চলতি বছরের ৯ এপ্রিল থেকে বাগজোলা খালের ওপর সেতু তৈরির কাজ শুরু হওয়ায় সেতুর ওপরের রাস্তায় যান চলাচল একেবারে বন্ধ করে দেয় পূর্ব দক্ষিণের দমদম জংশনে থেকে নাপেরবাজার আসতে গেলে যাত্রীদের হনুমন্দির পর্যন্ত

# Delhi's draft climate action plan aims to reduce dependence on hydropower from other states



Delhi doesn't have its own hydropower generation capability, it relies on other states for this power.

**NEW DELHI, AUG 7 /-** As Delhi prepares for the impact of climate change, the city government's draft action plan proposes a reduction in the national capital's reliance on hydropower from other states, taking into account potential future challenges to generation capacity due to changes in temperature and precipitation.

According to the Delhi Economic Survey 2022-23, the total electricity procured by Delhi in 2021-22 stood at 37,460 million units. Of this, about 16.65 per cent came from power plants owned by the Delhi government. The rest was bought from the central government and other states. With climate projections indicating rising temperatures and intensified periods of heavy rainfall, the energy and power sector in Delhi faces a slew of challenges. Extreme weather events, rising temperatures and altered precipitation patterns pose threats to both infrastructure and supply security. Hydropower output can be severely affected by changes in temperature and precipitation. Since

dropower and focus more on other renewable and clean energy sources, the report states. To encourage the use of clean solar energy in Delhi, the city government launched the Delhi Solar Policy in September 2016. The goal of the policy is to set up 2,000 mw of solar power installations by 2025. According to this policy, all government buildings with rooftops larger than 500 square metres must have solar panels installed. To make solar power more popular in homes, a Generation Based Incentive was offered for three years. This means people were rewarded for using solar power in their homes.

Data available till September 2022 shows there are solar power systems installed across 6,864 places in Delhi and together they can produce 244 mw of electricity. The draft plan recommends improving specifications for new structures to help those withstand extreme conditions such as higher wind speeds and safely handle higher temperatures. In some cases, retrofitting or moving vulnerable existing infra-

structure might be necessary. The draft State Action Plan on Climate Change (SAPCC) has highlighted that underground distribution can protect against wind, high temperatures, corrosion and flooding. Similarly, higher design standards for distribution poles can guard against strong winds and floods. Additionally, better cooling systems for substations and transformers will help manage rising temperatures.

For solar photovoltaic systems, it says designs that improve airflow under mounting structures can reduce panel temperature and boost power output. Using heat resistant cells, modules and components is also a good idea. The plan recommends setting up quick-response repair teams to handle damages from extreme weather and disasters. This will speed up recovery during emergencies. According to the plan, Delhi is projected to suffer a staggering loss of Rs 2.75 lakh crore by 2050 due to the impact of climate change, with changes in precipitation and temperature patterns posing significant threats to the lives of the most vulnerable populations.

Pending approval, the draft plan highlights "heat waves/higher temperature and heavy precipitation events over fewer number of days" as major challenges that the city will confront in the upcoming years. India introduced its National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC) in 2008, following which state governments were instructed to create their own action plan, in alignment with the strategies laid out in the NAPCC. In January 2018, the Union government requested the states to revise and strengthen their SAPCCs, taking into account the

evolving national and international climate action, science and policy landscape. Delhi's previous climate action plan was finalised only in 2019, after a lengthy seven-year consultation with stakeholders, rendering it obsolete.

During the formulation of the new plan, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Sixth Assessment Report (IPCC AR6) was examined, analysing the impacts of different climate scenarios on annual maximum and minimum temperatures and precipitation, an expert who contributed to the plan said. The projections show a rise in summer maximum temperatures in Delhi by 1.5-degree Celsius based on the RCP 4.5 scenario, and a 2.1-degree Celsius increase based on the RCP 8.5 scenario by mid-century. Four Representative Concentration Pathways (RCPs) span a range of future global warming scenarios. RCPs quantify future greenhouse gas concentrations and the radiative forcing—the difference between the incoming and outgoing radiation at the top of the atmosphere—due to increases in climate change pollution. At the Paris climate talks in 2015, countries agreed to limit global warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius as compared to the pre-industrial levels to avoid extreme, destructive and likely irreversible effects of climate change. The Earth's global surface temperature has risen by around 1.15 degrees Celsius and the CO2 spewed into the atmosphere since the start of the industrial revolution is closely tied to it. In the business-as-usual scenario, the world is heading for a temperature rise of around 3 degrees Celsius by the end of the century. (PTI)

# LS clears Digital Personal Data Protection Bill

## • It can have adverse impact on press freedom, says Editors Guild

**NEW DELHI, AUG 7 /-** The Lok Sabha on Monday cleared the Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Bill by a voice vote amid slogan shouting by Opposition members over the Manipur issue. Some amendments moved by Opposition members were defeated by a voice vote.

Moving the Bill for consideration and passage, Union IT Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said Opposition members had little concern for issues such as public welfare and the protection of people's personal data, and hence, they were raising slogans. Vaishnaw also urged the House to pass the Bill unanimously. The Bill seeks to protect the privacy of Indian citizens while proposing a penalty of up to Rs 250 crore on entities for misusing or failing to protect the digital data of individuals. The bill which comes after six years of the Supreme Court declaring "Right to Privacy" as a fundamental right has provisions to curb the misuse of individuals' data by online platforms.

Meanwhile, the Editors Guild of India has expressed concerns over certain provisions of the Bill, saying they

can have an adverse impact on press freedom. In a statement issued on Sunday, the Guild said the DPDP Bill creates an enabling framework for the surveillance of citizens, including journalists and their sources. The Guild has asked Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla to refer the Bill to a parliamentary standing committee. It has also written about its concerns on the Bill to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Rajya Sabha Chairman Jagdeep Thakur, IT Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw and leaders of political parties in Parliament. Under Section 36 of the DPDP Bill, the Guild said, the government can ask any public or private entity (data fiduciary) to furnish personal information of citizens, including journalists and their sources. It also voiced concerns over clause 17(2)(a) that allows the Union government to issue a notification exempting any "instrumentality of the State" from the provisions of this Bill, thereby keeping them out of the ambit of data protection restrictions, including internal sharing and processing of data. Section 17(4) allows the government and its in-

strumentalities to retain personal data for an unlimited period of time, it added.

"We note, with dismay, that while the Bill, ostensibly to promote data protection, has failed to make any provisions that bring about the surveillance reform that is urgently needed, and in fact creates an enabling framework for surveillance of citizens, including journalists and their sources," the Guild said. It said it is deeply concerned about the lack of exemptions for journalists from certain obligations of the law where the reporting on certain entities in public interest may conflict with their right to personal data protection. "This will lead to a chilling effect on journalistic activity in the country," the Guild said.

It said certain provisions of the Bill also shift the balance in favour of non-disclosure of information, including information sought by journalists in public interest, thereby reducing accountability. The Guild has also flagged concerns over the composition of the Data Protection Board and stressed the need for it to be independent of the government. (PTI)

# Both Houses of UP legislature rocked over Manipur violence

**LUCKNOW, AUG 7 /-** Opposition parties in the Uttar Pradesh Assembly raised the Manipur issue on the opening day of the Monsoon session on Monday, demanding that the House pass a resolution condemning the ethnic strife in the North-Eastern state.

Samajwadi Party, Rashtriya Lok Dal and the Congress also demanded a statement from Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, who was present in the House, on the ongoing violence in the northeastern state and trooped into the well over the matter. Speaking in the Assembly during the Zero Hour, Leader of Opposition in the Assembly Akhilesh Yadav said the Manipur issue is "serious", adding: "Can't we pass a resolution to condemn it?" Speaker Satish Mahana turned down the plea asking members to stick to the state's issue. Akhilesh said: "Uttar Pradesh is the largest state in the country, and even the prime minister represents the state from his constituency here. So at least on Manipur violence, we hope that you (Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath) will speak and condemn it." Modi is second consecutive term Lok Sabha MP from Varanasi.

Akhilesh also said: "The Leader of the House (Yogi Adityanath) is a star campaigner of the saffron party. In which state do you not go to ask for votes? At least there is a chance that today you can become the voice of the country by saying something. And if you need our support for this, we are ready. Today, you can prove that you too have a voice." Refusing the

Opposition's demand, the Speaker said tradition and convention do not allow the House to take up the matter. Responding to the SP chief, Speaker Mahana said: "Everybody has condemned it here, but the Vidhan Sabha cannot speak about other states." The Speaker said: "Leader of Opposition, you are very competent, and you should not give it a political shape. Whatever happened was extremely wrong."

The discussion will take place where the incident took place. If anything is happening in Bengal and Kerala, it cannot be stated as wrong or right here." The Speaker also turned down the demand by Congress leader Aradhana Mishra who demanded that the matter be taken up in the House after suspending listed business.

Before the SP chief spoke, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Suresh Khanna said: "Everybody knows about the incident, which happened in Manipur. The respective state government or the Centre may discuss it, do anything, but this subject does not pertain to here. Therefore, there should be no discussion on it." Taking on the Opposition, Khanna asked how many resolutions were passed in the House condemning the 2016 "exodus" from Kairana in Muzaffarnagar. "The incident of Jawahar Bagh took place, how many

resolutions were passed? They (the then SP government) could have said that they will pass a resolution to condemn it," Khanna said and accused the opposition of wasting the time of the House.

The then BJP MP Hukum Singh had in June 2016 claimed that close to 350 Hindus had left Kairana over alleged threats and extortion by criminal elements belonging to a particular community. More than 20 people, including the two police officials, were killed in June 2016 during a drive to evict squatters at Jawahar Bagh. With the agitating Opposition members refusing to end the protest on the Manipur issue and return to their seats, the House was adjourned for the day by the Speaker. The issue came up in the UP Legislative Council too where SP members staged a protest in the upper house over women being paraded naked on the streets of Manipur. When the proceedings began at 11 am, SP MLC Lal Bihari Yadav and other members of his party pressed over discussing the Manipur issue first. Chairperson Kunwar Manvendra Singh asked them to raise the matter after the Question Hour and that he would listen to the matter during the Zero Hour, but the opposition members refused to relent and continued their protest, following which the chairman adjourned the house for the day. (PTI)

# Man charred to death in car explosion in Kerala

**ALAPPUZHA, AUG 7 /-** A 35-year-old man was charred to death inside his car on Monday after the vehicle he was in exploded suddenly just after midnight, just as it entered the compound of his home in Mavelikkara near here, police said.

Mavelikkara resident Krishna Prakash was unable to get out of the car when the explosion took place. The incident occurred at around 12.30 AM today, they said. A team of forensic experts has examined the vehicle and the spot. "As per the information we got, the vehicle exploded all of a sudden as he entered the gate of his house, and he was unable to leave the car," police said. Krishna Prakash, who was unmarried and lived with his brother, was running a computer shop in Mavelikkara town, they said.

After examining the car, the officials said there were indications that the victim had tried to escape from the burning vehicle. Officials

from the state Motor Vehicles Department examined the car and ruled out short circuit as the reason for the explosion. The fire was not reported from the engine part of the car either, and it was the back of the car that was badly burnt. No major complaint has been reported about the fuse unit either, which is at the front portion of the car, and neither was its battery affected, they said.

Top police officers visited the site but declined to provide more details. (PTI)

# Baghel writes to PM over irregular train operations in Chhattisgarh

**RAIPUR, AUG 7 /-** Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel has written to Prime Minister Narendra Modi to highlight the problems faced by people due to irregular operations of passenger trains in the state, an official said on Monday.

According to a statement issued by the public relations department, Baghel in his letter said the Railways had cancelled several trains without any prior intimation and passengers have not been informed how long these trains will remain cancelled. Apart from the cancellations, commuters are also inconvenienced due to train delays, he said. The Chief Minister further said that he had written to the railway minister in the past for smooth operation of passenger trains, but the situation has not improved. "Students, pilgrims, patients, businessmen, labourers among other com-

muters are severely inconvenienced due to irregular operation of trains. There is anger among the people of the state, and the credibility of the state government and the Railways is being questioned," Baghel wrote. Due to the geographical conditions in Chhattisgarh, the density of trains is less than the national average, he said, adding that trains are the only accessible mode of transport for people living in remote areas. (PTI)

# Train firing: Accused RPF constable's police custody extended till Aug 11

**MUMBAI, AUG 7 /-** A court here on Monday extended the police remand of Railway Protection Force (RPF) constable Chetan Singh till August 7 for allegedly shooting dead his senior colleague and three passengers on a moving train. The Government Railway Police (GRP) sought the extension of his custody for seven days, saying they need to identify the witnesses and scan CCTV footage. The magistrate, however, granted Singh's custody to the police till August 11. The GRP has added Indian Penal Code section 153-A, for promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion, in the case against Singh. The incident took place on July 31 on board the moving Jaipur-Mumbai Central Express near Palghar railway station in Maharashtra. Accused constable Chetan Singh (34) allegedly shot dead his senior-RPF Assistant Sub-Inspector Tikaram Meena and three passengers on board the train, officials said. Singh was nabbed with his weapon later while trying to flee after passengers pulled the chain of the train which stopped near Mira Road station (on the Mumbai suburban network). (PTI)

The counsel for the NIA said he would file the relevant material before the bench. In 2017, the NIA had registered a case against 12 persons for alleged conspiracy to raise and collect funds for causing disruption by way of pelting stones, damaging public property and conspiring to wage war against the government of India. Shah was arrested in the matter on June 4, 2019.

# Delhi HC seeks NIA stand on bail plea of Kashmiri separatist leader Shabir Shah in terror funding case

**NEW DELHI, AUG 7 /-** The Delhi High Court on Monday sought the stand of the National Investigation Agency (NIA) on a plea by Kashmiri separatist leader Shabir Ahmad Shah seeking bail in a terror funding case.

A bench of Justices Siddharth Mridul and Anish Dayal issued notice to the NIA on an appeal filed by the accused against a trial court order refusing to grant him bail. It allowed time to the agency to place on record the relevant documents. Senior advocate Colin Gosalves sought bail on behalf of the appellant on the ground that "it was a no material case".

The appellant has been languishing in jail in the present case for four years, with over 400 witnesses to be examined and only 15 witnesses having been examined till date in over four years," the appeal said.

# Kerala Assembly session begins; tributes paid to Chandy, Purushothaman

**THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, AUG 7 /-** The ninth session of the 15th Kerala Legislative Assembly commenced on Monday here with Speaker A N Shamsheer, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan and various other legislators paying tributes to former CM Gommen Chandy and Congress veteran Vakkom Purushothaman, both of whom died last month.

Both Shamsheer, Vijayan and various other Legislators, including Leader of Opposition in the state As-

sembly V D Sathesnan recalled the respective contributions of Chandy and Purushothaman in the political sphere of the state and how with their demise, an important chapter in Kerala politics has come to an end. This is the first session of the House in more than five decades in which Chandy, who died in Bengaluru on July 18, will not be present as a representative of Puthuppally Assembly constituency in Kottayam district. He had represented that constitu-

ency for 53 years straight as he won from there 12 times in a row starting from 1970, everyone remembered. Everyone in the House was of the view that Chandy, who was twice Chief Minister of the state, was able to achieve this feat through his hard work and perseverance which he did not give up even when he was seriously ill.

Chandy's sincerity towards public work was an example for the new generation as well, they all said. Purushothaman, who died here on July 31, held the record of being twice Speaker of the Kerala Assembly in addition to being the Governor of Mizoram and Tripura and Lt Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, they said while paying tributes to him.

They said that he played a leadership role at most levels of the democratic process as he was part of legislative bodies from the panchayat to the Parliament during his over seven decades long career.

Purushothaman was a minister three times, handled many important portfolios like finance, health, excise, labour, agriculture and tourism collectively, they said. Shamsheer, Vijayan and Sathesnan said that Purushothaman's political career spanning over seven decades was an excellent reference for all public servants, especially the newer generation. After paying tributes to the two veteran leaders, the House concluded for the day and will resume on Tuesday. (PTI)
