

Dharanipur tea garden reopens after 20 years

MI News Service, Siliguri: Dharanipur tea garden which had remained closed for nearly two decades, reopened on Friday. This tea garden under the Nagrakata block of Jalpaiguri is some 30 km away from the town headquarters. "We are happy that Dharanipur tea garden reopened today (Friday) after almost 20 years. The other two closed gardens, Surendra Nagar and Red Bank Prasad will also reopen on August 11," said Bulu Chik Baraik, the minister of state for backward classes' welfare and tribal development. The workers of the tea garden welcomed the minister, other Trinamul leaders as well as the new garden proprietors Shambhu Sha and Ganesh Prasad with a traditional tribal dance. The earlier owners had reportedly abandoned the garden after failing to pay

However, the efforts to reopen another tea garden in the district, the Raipur tea garden, remained inconclusive as the garden management did not attend a tripartite meeting convened by Jalpaiguri district magistrate Moumita Godara

Basu on Friday. The lease of the garden in the name of a businessman Gouri Shankar "The management of Raipur left the garden in September 2018. The labor department officially declared the tea garden closed in January 2019 and since then 558

workers of the garden are jobless," an administrative source said. The district magistrate had also served a showcause notice to the management of Raipur garden, asking him to explain why no litigation was being taken to reopen the garden. A source, however, said the garden management had appealed to the administration to provide some time as he reportedly requires Rs. 35 crore to clear all dues. "We have been able to reopen almost all closed tea gardens in the district. We will convene a meeting and make efforts to reopen the Raipur garden as early as possible," the district magistrate said. Sources said that the meeting is likely to be held next month in Swapan Sarkar, a leader of Trinamul-affiliated tea workers union, is at the garden would reopen soon.

This ritual had been continuing for a long time in the area, but for the first time decision of blood donation was taken by the Muharram Committee after discussion with everyone. These efforts are being made to spread this message among more Muharram committees. They said that 50 people donated blood that day. BDO (Ausgram-1) Arindam Mukherjee appreciated this initiative.

CBI arrests son of industrialist Mahimananda Mishra, in Paradip Port Trust bribery case

MI News Service, New Delhi: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Saturday arrested Charchit Mishra, son of leading Odisha industrialist Mahimananda Mishra and MD of Stevedores Limited. The CBI also nabbed builder Shishir Das in an alleged bribery case involving officials of Paradip Port Trust. On Friday, CBI arrested a Chief Mechanical Engineer of Paradip Port Trust in Odisha and three private persons including a conduit, middleman etc. in the same case. "The four persons who were arrested on Friday have been sent to five days

of police custody by the court. The two who were arrested today will be produced before the court," said a senior CBI official. He added that Charchit Mishra was named in the accused list of FIR registered by CBI but Shishir was arrested during an investigation after they received Rs. 10 lakh for Rs. 10 lakh bribe amount kept at his house. A case was registered against Chief Mechanical Engineer, Paradip Port Trust (Odisha), and others including private persons, private companies and unknown others. It was alleged that the

During further searches, Rs. 20.25 lakh (approx.), jewelry, documents related to investment and other incriminating documents were recovered from the residence of the Chief Mechanical Engineer.

Shooting at Imbarara Hospital in Chunchura again, patients rushed in fear

At that time the hospital was crowded. According to eyewitnesses, there were several miscreants in the crowd among the patient's family members. Toton was taken out of the hospital.

In which it is stated that many immovable properties have been registered in the name of you and your family from the year 2013 to 2022, in which various types of irregularities are visible. You have been working as an official and political worker with Nishu Kumar, a well-known party leader, for a long time," the letter added. He gave him the opportunity to serve as a two-time member of the Rajya

Sabha, the party's National General Secretary (Organisation), National President and Union Minister. You are aware of the fact that our leaders have been working on zero tolerance for corruption and despite having been in public life for a long time, they have no stain on their feet nor have they amassed any wealth. The party expects you to convey your clear views on the points of grievance to the party immediately."

It may be noted that RCP Singh is accused of buying 40 bighas of land in two blocks of Nalanda district, Isthwan and Islampur, during the year 2013-2022. RCP Singh is also accused of taking land as a donation. Although the RCP has not yet responded to the notice sent by the JDU, but after this action taken by the party, it is being assumed that the JDU will take action against RCP Singh. And can take even greater action than this.

'Polio' virus in New York water, fear of infecting hundreds of people

MI News Service, New York: In New York, the risk of poliovirus infection has increased significantly. This is because the polio virus has been found in the county's wastewater. After the news, New York officials warned that hundreds of residents could already be infected with the devastating polio. Officials have detected the presence of poliovirus in two separate areas of Orange County in June-July. The place is about an hour's drive from New York City. The warning comes within a week of finding a case of polio in Rockland County. The virus was also detected in Rockland's wastewater last month. Officials say the possibility of the polio virus spreading through contaminated water is low,

but not impossible. Because water treatment is of a high standard in the United States, it is difficult for a person to drink contaminated water. Most cases of polio are either mild or asymptomatic, so it is likely that there are hundreds of cases that will never be detected. The detection of the case in Orange County confirms fears that the virus may have been spreading before the Rockland case was detected. The good thing is that vaccinated people don't need to worry, because they won't be infected. America has more than 90 percent vaccination coverage, which is encouraging. Immunization is required to go to primary school and then the effect of this vaccination is

lifelong. A person does not need a booster to be protected from the virus. However, officials are advising people to get vaccinated to protect the spread of the polio virus. In Orange County, 59 percent of people have been vaccinated, while in Rockland, only 60 percent have received a polio dose. Meanwhile, state health commissioner Dr. Mary Bassett said that based on past polio cases, New Yorkers should know that for every case of congenital polio, hundreds of others can be infected. Based on new wastewater results, the department is considering this as a potential spill. The department has said that based on the data, it believes that the risk of polio exists in New York

BSP MP Atul Rai acquitted in rape case, woman had committed self-immolation

MI News Service, Varanasi: A Varanasi court has acquitted Atul Rai, the BSP MP from Ghosi seat in Moo district, in a rape case. The alleged rape victim attempted self-immolation before the Supreme Court two days ago. A woman from Ballia, who was a college student, filed a case of rape against MP Atul Roy, who is

lodged in Nini Jail, at the Lanka Police Station in Varanasi in 2019. Later, the accused woman and a friend of hers committed self-immolation before the Supreme Court, dying days later. Special Judge Syaram Chaurasia delivered the verdict through video conferencing at around 10.30 am on Saturday. However, Ghost MP

Atul Rai will not be able to be released from jail yet as the case against him is also pending in Lucknow. The woman's lawyer, Rajesh Yadav, said that the verdict has been delivered orally and the copy of the order is being edited. Only after receiving the copy will it be clear on what basis Atul Roy has been released. Atul Roy had

sundered in a Varanasi court after winning the Lok Sabha elections in June 2019. Since then he is in jail and is currently in Nani General Jail in Allahabad. The rape-accused student and her friend had committed self-immolation before the Supreme Court in August 2021 and there they died.

After death of Zawahiri, Kabul rocked by explosions, at least 8 dead

MI News Service, Kabul: The capital of Afghanistan was rocked by an explosion just after the death of Al Qaeda leader Ayman Al-Zawahiri. At least eight people were killed in an explosion in a populated area of the community of Kabul. At least eight people lost their lives in that attack. However, IS claimed that at least 20 people were killed in the blast. It is good to say that the Sunni militant organization Islamic State has been targeting the Shia community in

Afghanistan. In this regard, the spokesman of Kabul Police, Khalid Zedran, said that the militants detonated an explosion in the capital's populated area in an attempt to cause a large-scale loss of life. Militants planted explosives in a vegetable cart. The news men reported, citing a Taliban leader. The number of casualties in the explosion in the crowded area is 50. Many of the injured are seriously injured and the death toll is expected to rise. Note that in August 2021, Kabul was occupied by the Taliban. Despite the departure of US forces, IS became a headache for Akhundzad's organization. The Islamic State Khurasan militants attacked multiple Taliban lead-

ers, including at Kabul airport, after the withdrawal of US forces. Last May, three consecutive explosions rocked Mazar-e-Sharif, the capital of Balkh province. Militants blew up three buses. Nine people died in that attack. At least 15 people were injured. The Taliban commander in the region, Mohammed Asif Waziri, told that almost all of the dead and wounded belonged to Afghanistan's minority Shia Muslim community. And the Shias were targeted by the militants. In the same month, an explosion occurred in the Hazrat Zakaria Mosque in Kabul. At least 30 people died. Incidentally, both the Taliban and IS are Sunni jihadist organizations. However, the con-

flikt between the two groups over the interpretation and doctrine of Islam, is intense. IS claims that the Taliban is part of America's 'Mullah Bradley' project. According to the fundamentalists, the US has weakened the jihad on the part of Taliban by growing in a part of that project. In particular, the conflict escalated after IS's Khurasan branch was created in Afghanistan's Nangarhar province in 2015. Various groups have started supporting the Taliban to fight IS. Later, IS suffered a major blow as a result of the American operation in Nangarhar province. But they are gaining strength again.
