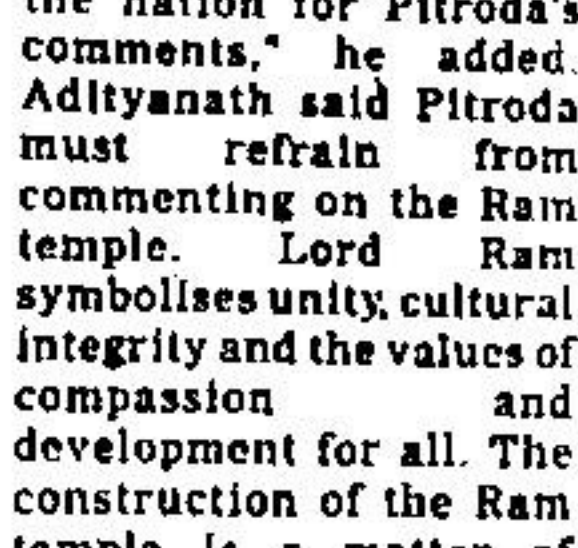

## Retailers to step up hiring this year as industry expands

More than half of Indian retailers (52%) are planning to onboard fresh graduates this year, while about two in five (38%) retailers are seeking to recruit experienced professionals, according to a report by staffing and recruitment firm GI Group.

In 2023, the retail industry experienced an 8% rise in job applications, while demand surged by 18%, indicating a strong interest in retail hiring. This was driven by retailers continuing their expansion across tier-1 and tier-2 cities.

beauty retail, requiring more personnel.

According to the report, 87% of retail applicants in 2023 were aged between 18 and 30, signalling a strong inclination among the youth towards careers in retail.

The data also reflects the rapid expansion by offline retailers over the past couple of years. For instance, gross leasing stood at 2.8 million square feet in the first half of 2023, according to real estate consulting firm CBRE, far outstripping new retail supply in the market.

The vacancy rate—the percentage of vacant space in a given mall—declined sharply after the pandemic due to robust leasing on the back of aggressive expansion plans of retailers, coupled with limited availability of quality retail spaces, the report said.

GI Group's report also signalled a significant uptick in hiring trends in the e-commerce and logistics sectors as more shippers who turned to delivery platforms during the pandemic lockdowns stayed with the habit.

Meanwhile, the logistics sector faced a 13.89% decline in active jobs during the December quarter, attributed to challenges during peak season fulfilment.

However, the onset of 2024 saw a promising 10.24% increase in new job postings, with projections of continued growth leading up to this year's peak season, it said.

# IT cos must hire more women

Experts say the share of female employees in the IT sector has plateaued at 36-39% over the past year

The share of female employees in the IT sector has remained more or less flat at 36-39% over the past year, and more needs to be done to increase this number, gender and diversity experts told *Mint*.

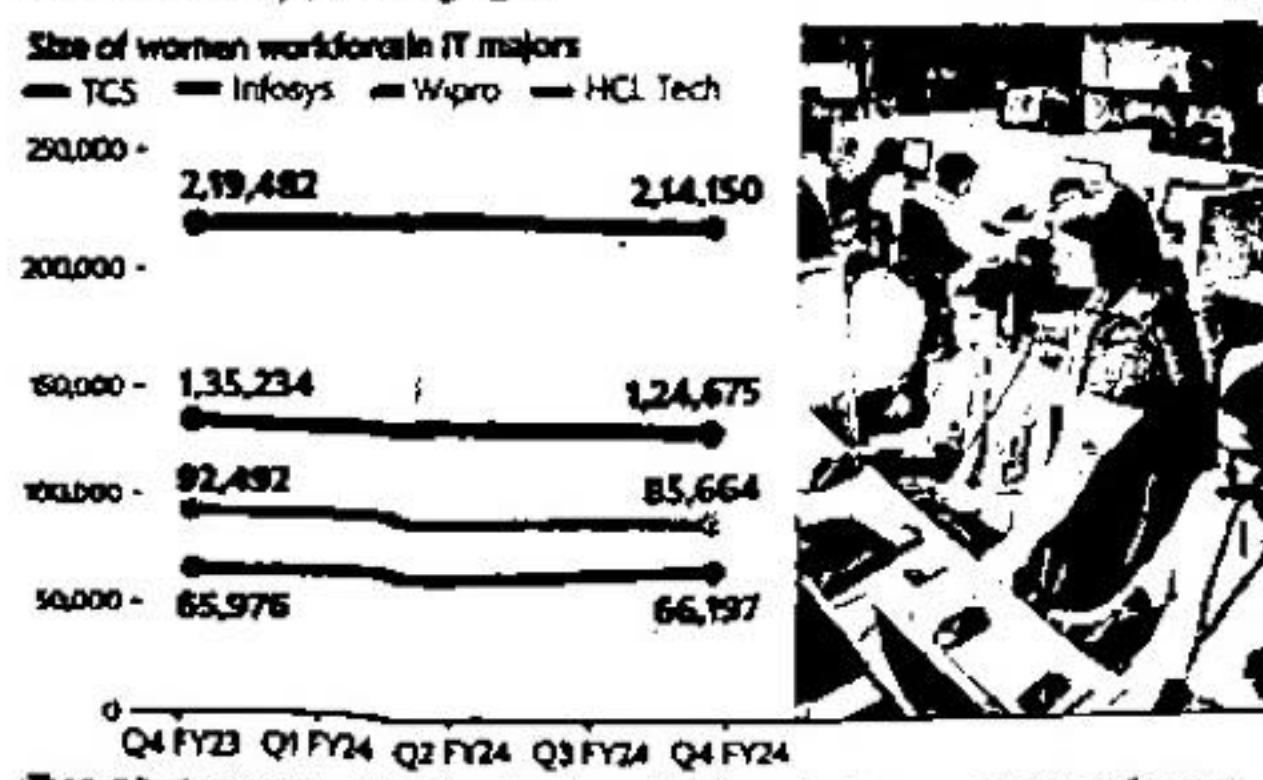
They cautioned that the sector, which has relatively high women's representation, is seeing more women exit in the middle and senior levels. While the ongoing push to bring employees back to offices will increase drop-outs, companies need to ensure that women employees can acquire new skills so that they stay on board, experts said.

According to a *Mint* analysis, Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Infosys, Wipro, and HCL Technologies saw their combined workforce drop by over 60,000 in FY24, while the overall share of women in these four companies remained unchanged at 35.5% as of 31 March, compared with 35.6% a year ago.

While the share of female employees at these four firms remained about the same over the past year, their absolute number fell by 22,498. Aparna Mittal, founder of the

Samra Centre for Gender, Policy and Law, said, "It is possible that the vigour with which the IT sector increased its diversity quotient from small numbers to 35% has now plateaued. A certain psychological barrier comes in where companies become complacent because they have a more diverse workforce than many other firms in India."

Although the IT services sector has

been recruiting en masse from engineering campuses, they need to study the reasons why female employees quit, and whether enough women are hired to replace those that leave. Mittal added.

Akhilesh Tuteja, partner and national leader, clients and markets and technology, media and telecommunications (TMT) at NPMG in India, noted that many IT companies were

investing in training, hiring, and mentoring women, which will build a stronger pipeline of female leaders. "The fact that already half the new hires are women is a positive sign. I am optimistic that this ongoing focus on diversity will lead to a more balanced IT workforce in the coming years," he said.

At TCS, the share of female employees remained nearly flat at 35.6% as of 31 March from 35.7% a year ago, with 5,300 fewer women in the workforce.

At Infosys, the share of female employees declined from 39.4% to 39.3%, with a net reduction of more than 10,000.

At Wipro, the share of women in the workforce increased from 36% to 36.6% over the same period, but their absolute number fell by about 7,000.

HCL Tech, meanwhile, saw the share of women employees fall marginally from 29.2% to 29.1%, but their absolute number increased as the company did not see overall attrition in FY24; its workforce grew by 1,537 employees.

There has been a renewed push for gender diversity since the number of

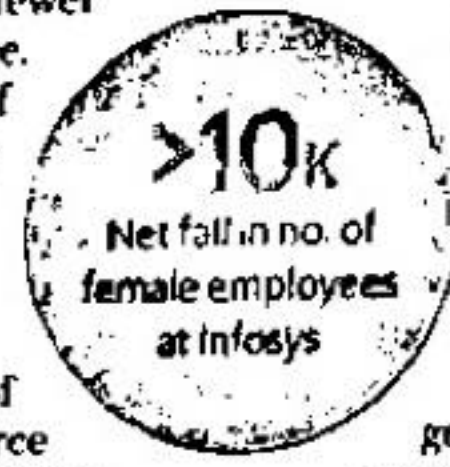
female drop-outs shot up during the pandemic as many had to juggle responsibilities at home and work. However, a slowdown in recruitment will likely cause diversity numbers to stagnate as well.

Nirmala Menon, founder of Interweave Consulting, which works on diversity and gender parity in Indian firms, said companies must keep track of whether female employees are receiving adequate training.

"Across industries, including IT, women require more persuasion to acquire skills. IT firms must get more women trained in skills such as AI to prevent drop-outs," she added.

The need for increased gender diversity is prompting many IT firms to recruit more women from colleges.

"Over the past couple of years we have seen higher recruitment of women from campuses in the IT services sector. However, shifting to another location remains a challenge for many of the women candidates," said the placement head at one of Bengaluru's largest engineering colleges.



## IPL matches had 510 mn viewers

Disney Star, the television broadcaster of IPL 2024, said on Thursday that 510 million people have watched the tournament's 51 matches so far. Citing numbers shared by the Broadcast Audience Research Council (BARC), Disney Star said the cumulative watch time for IPL 2024 on television was up 18% from the 2023 edition, reflecting sustained engagement and interest from viewers.

With 17 matches still left to go, the broadcaster said it has already surpassed the cumulative audience reach achieved in seven of the eight previous editions of the tournament, as measured by BARC.

It added that the television viewer ratings (TVR) for the



The IPL tournament has so far held 51 encounters.

first 51 matches were 5% higher than the previous record, set in 2019, which suggests a widening viewership base and an expanding reach across television audiences.

TVR is a metric used to measure the popularity of a television program or broadcast and represents the television households or individuals

watching a programme as a percentage of the number of television households or individuals in a demographic.

Digital broadcast partner Jio Cinema has not released any fresh viewership figures. In mid-April, 29 matches into the tournament, it said it had clocked more than 38.3 crore viewers on the platform, up 42% from the same period last season. It also said viewers on connected TVs spent an average of more than 80 minutes watching each match.

A recent report by GroupM ESP, the sports division of GroupM India, said sports sponsorships in India crossed ₹15,766 crore in 2023, an increase of 10.95% from ₹14,209 crore in the previous year. This expenditure included ground fees, team and franchise fees, athlete endorsements, and media spending.

Tata Group-owned Indian Hotels Company Ltd (IHCL), which operates the Taj Group of hotels, on Thursday announced Ekyam, a new marketing platform that will manage a portfolio of 25 hotels and 2,500 rooms by the end of 2025.

Ekyam will primarily manage properties across destinations that offer adventure experiences across the Indian Ocean, Greater Himalayan regions and wildlife escapes, and will club IHCL's existing and seven upcoming properties owned by its long-time partner Nepali diversified business conglomerate CG Group's

CG Hospitality.

These 11 properties—Taj Exotica Resort & Spa and Taj Coral Reef Resort & Spa in Maldives, Taj Samudra in Colombo, Taj Jumeirah Lakes Towers in Dubai, and Taj Safaris, the wildlife luxury lodges in India (Bandhavgarh, Kanha, Pench, and Panna) and Nepal (Chitwan and Kathmandu)—have 900 rooms in the Indian sub-continent and west Asia.

The seven upcoming properties of this expanded partnership will include four in Nepal, two in Bhutan and one in Dubai under the platform, which will

add 900 rooms to the portfolio. IHCL has identified seven of its existing managed properties with other developers that it plans to add to Ekyam, said MD and CEO Puneet Chhatwal. This, he said, will depend on

approvals from the owners of those properties.

"This is a marketing platform, which will house our owned and managed properties with CG Hospitality and their upcoming properties. It is imagined to bring in more transparency and build on the already existing two-decade-old partnership that we have with them," said Chhatwal.
